### Travel Plan

This Travel Information Plan aims to give our staff, customers and visitors practical travel information to and from our premises to encourage sustainable travel by bus, bike and on foot. Traffic jams and parking pressures can be a major source of frustration, so please make the most of this information and do your bit to keep Twickenham moving. Please remember that this commitment was agreed as part of our planning consent and is an integral part of that agreement to help ensure traffic impact to our neighbours is mitigated over time. We encourage our staff and parents to use public transport, bikes, walking and car shares whenever possible. We hold 'We will walk to nursery' events throughout the year. As the ethos of our nursery is to promote healthy living we try to encourage our staff, parents and children to live by this during everyday events.

### Your travel options:

- On Foot

You can find our building located on the corner of London Road and Cole Park Road. You can plan your journey on foot using the 'walking' button on google maps. The nursery provides dry storage facilities for pushchairs and scooters.

- By Bike

We have plenty of space in our drive for anyone who wishes to use their bike for commuting to and from the nursery. We have side access for the staff to store their bikes safely during the day and they have access to the staff room/cloakroom should they need to change before commencing work.

- By Bus

From Twickenham station the 267 and 110 stop opposite the nursery.

From Isleworth, the 267, 481, 110 all pass the nursery on the main road.

From Hounslow the H20 passes the nursery on the main road.

From Richmond/ St Margarets the H37 stop is a short walk from the nursery.

- By rail

The nearest stations to the nursery are Twickenham Rail Station and St Margarets Rail station, with services being provided by Transport for London.

Richmond station is easily accessible by either public transport, walking or car.

- By car

There is a drop off and pick up space outside the nursery on Cole Park Road. There is no resisted parking (excluding rugby days) on Cole Park Road. Parents, staff and visitors may park their short or long term subject to availability, however we do encourage the use of public transport, walking or cycling.

Please note if you are dropping off or picking up from the nursery we ask that you do not do a turn in the road as it is unsafe and instead you use the turning point at the end of the cul-de-sac.

To ensure safety we ask parents and carers to please hold your child's hand when entering and exiting the nursery.
